

## **Waldemarsudde, Djurgården, Stockholm, Sweden**

Walk in the paths around Waldemarsudde and enjoy a visit to the museum.

Waldemarsudde is originally the home of Prince Eugen, the son of Oscar II (1865-1947). It became state-owned after the Prince's death and in accordance with his will. It is now among the most-visited art museums in Sweden.



Plan a walk when it suits you. Bring a friend, pack a picnic lunch or plan to stop at the cafés. The 47 bus goes to the park entrance.
