

Djurgården, Stockholm, Sweden

Djurgården means Garden of Animals. Skansen (partially the home of animals) is located here and there are many pleasant walking paths.

The 47 bus stops just across the Djurgårds bridge in front of the Nordiska Museet. Or, take the bus to the end stop and begin walking there.



Follow the blue dots and add a little extra by taking some of the side paths. Rosendal and Waldermarsudde are both interesting and have lovely gardens. Plan two or three hours to enjoy the island and to stop at any of the restaurants or cafés.
